- The Capitol Building - Seat of the United States Congress in Washington, D.C., it was built on a hill called Capitol Hill. The Capitol contains floor space equivalent to 1.6 hectares (four acres). A neoclassical - style building, the Capitol is constructed of white marble, except for the center part of the West Front, which is Virginia Stone but has been painted white.
- The Holocaust Memorial Museum - In Washington, D.C., dedicated to presenting the history of the persecution and murder of six million Jews and millions of other victims of Nazi tyranny from 1933 to 1945. It was established in 1980 by the Congress of the United States and opened in 1993. This Federal Museum was built with private donations.
- The National Air and Space Museum - A comprehensive survey of the evolution of air and space technology is presented in this museum. Eight exhibit areas house dozens of air and spacecraft.
